What is Hospice

Hospice is a philosophy of caring

Hospice care is a specialized care that focuses on supporting you and your loved ones during an advanced illness. The emphasis is on comfort and quality of life, rather than finding a cure. Hospice care enables you to live each day to the fullest as comfortably and dignified as possible.

Benefits of Hospice

Hospice care not only helps with managing your symptoms, but also helps you and your family with emotional and spiritual support.

You don't have to be ready for hospice. In fact, hospice doesn't expect you to be ready. You just have to be eligible for the services which can increase the quality of your life. Many people think that hospice care is for the last few days of life, when in fact patients can receive it much earlier. In customer satisfaction surveys, many families said they wish they had known about hospice sooner. Receiving hospice care may help you avoid frequent trips to the hospital.

Who Is Eligible

Patients must meet certain criteria in order to be eligible for hospice. We will work with you and your physician to determine eligibility. Medicare's guidelines include:

- · Documented life-limiting prognosis by a certified physician(s)
- ·The patient elects to receive comfort (palliative) care
