This is a three year commitment; no additional maintenance costs will occur in the first three years. Negotiation will take place on whether we continue using the service at the end of the three years.</li></ul>

- [FAC Laptop upgrade](#) – Timothy R. Espinosa - \$65,088.00 - 48 Panasonic Toughbook CF53s, 48 Port replicator for CF-53, 48 adapters. The Detectives that work for the Violent Crimes division are on an on call status which requires them to be out in the field at all hours of the day and night. They must return to their office before they can start writing up their cases. By outfitting them with these computers they will be able to be connected through their laptop and have access to the databases they need while out in the field
- [FAC computer upgrade](#) – Timothy R. Espinosa - \$47,445.20 - 22 PNY GEforce video cards, 44 planar monitors  
70 Microsoft office licenses, 22 HP SB 600 computers. The Family Advocacy Center is in need of upgrading several computers. They are working with computers that are several years old and are outdated. These will allow them to keep up with the current technology.
- [fire station access points](#) – Cedric O. Dalton - \$43,565.12 - wireless access points for all AFD -fire stations to replace aging equipment already in place and installs in new stations. This will improve mobility and connection status, with units using mobile.com. To provide wireless access points to employees.
- [Zetron interface](#) – Timothy R. Espinosa - \$29,925.00 - This is an interface that combines APD with the Albuquerque Fire Department. It is part of the Tiburon VMP.
- [Teletime](#) – Andre O'Brien - \$37,000.00 - Professional services for Teletime implementation for the Kronos project. Kronos is the "time clock" application for the City of Albuquerque
- [Biopark and Compass Core Equipment](#) – Kristen L. Woodard - \$71,934.25 - We are continuing to connect more city facilities via 10 gig fiber. We are currently in need of connecting additional 10 gig fiber and also upgrading our 1 gig connections to 10 gig at both Compass Bank and the Biopark. This equipment is necessary as we are unable to support 10 gig capabilities at these two locations. Connecting via 10 gig fiber will increase the bandwidth available to our sites, reduce reoccurring telecom fees for rented circuits, and add redundancy and reliability to the City's network.
- [Wireless Controllers](#) – Kristen L. Woodard - \$49,374.16 - Our three primary wireless controllers have reached their end of life. The newest wireless access points are no longer supported on these wireless controllers. 2 of these devices will be able to support the amount of APs being handled by the three end of life devices. We will place one of these controllers at Pino Yards for DR, and the other will remain at City Hall. This will allow us to continue updating our technology to give the best experience possible to the end user and also ensure our network security.
- [Palo Alto Web Filtering](#) – Kristen L. Woodard - \$36,249.47 - Currently the public wifi is completely unfiltered. This device will allow for filtering to prevent the viewing and downloading of illegal material. Due to security reasons, we require a completely separate appliance for filtering the public wifi connection.
