## 1. Description The Environmental Health Department (EHD) is requesting a review of the proposal to replace the existing legacy EnvisionConnect software. The selected product is from Tyler Technologies. 2. Business Case / Justification The current EnvisionConnect software is considered a legacy system and headed toward being phased out by the vendor(Accela). The software is technically still supported, but no further development or improvements to the current software will take place by the vendor. Due to the current limitations of the EnvisionConnect software, EHD is unable to take advantage of current industry technology standards and solutions. In addition, the Tyler Technology suite of modules will enable the department to benefit from functionality that is lacking in the current EnvisionConnect system. A few items being: - API connectivity to third party systems - Online public portal/dashboard (applying for permits, manage and pay for permits, and viewing inspection results) - Customizable workflows - Integrated GIS functionality - Robust reporting - Customizable, user-role specific dashboards Another key element for EHD, will also be the added benefit from utilizing the same system as the City's Planning Department (with others to follow), making data sharing and utilizing common integrations much simpler and more efficient. Tyler Technologies is the only company in the sector that is solely dedicated to public sector solutions and is widely used throughout the country.
