Althea Atherton: There's been a change in the person in charge of the Board applications. You can also contact your City Councilor.

# TAB Chairperson's Report – Samuel Jensen, Chair

Samuel Jensen: Please pass the word along to anyone that may be interested in joining TAB.

### Director's Report: Leslie Keener, Director

Leslie Keener: Ridership for ART 188,000 for November and 183,000 December, Fixed Route 556,000 for November and 450, 000 for December. Paratransit 15,000 for November and 14,500 for December. Vacancy rates have started to come down, 34% for entire department. Hiring Event January 19. Our focus remains on hiring and retention. ART buses are being used on San Mateo route to help with overcrowding. Cleaning efforts on buses and stops continue to be an issue, but we do have our focus on that. We have a RFQ on exterior bus washing. We will start repainting shelters and rebranding with new decals. New signage on Central corridor in the next month or two. Metro has the ability to cite at our shelters. We have 35 new buses, you should see 5 in service in the next week. We'll space them out as we get them wrapped, do pre-delivery inspections and new radio installs. We have 20 new Sun Vans out and on the road. All advertising will go away with the R-23-184. Training on safety and procedures will be available digitally for our staff. You will see safety and security information on our dashboard in the next several weeks. New APD officers will be on our Central corridor. In February we can do a presentation on the new Micro Transit we will be introducing in March, branded ABQ Ride Connect. ART pin curbs are done. We're noting areas that need additional attention. All buses are equipped with GPS. It can be our Trapeze or Swiftly software down or not updating, but we will look into it because this is the first we are hearing this.

Steve Pilon: What's happening to old buses and Sun vans? On the budget positive, is it a 10% increase?

Leslie Keener: Buses and Sun vans will be decommissioned. We'll have more conversation on budget as we have more information.

Althea Atherton: Are new CNG buses equipped with passenger counter? Is there another place we can find safety data? Is Micro-Transit expanding routes where there is no bus service?

Leslie Keener: Driver will have to manually enter passengers. We will update dashboard with security information soon. Micro Transit is more for first mile, last mile.

Patrick Martin: Are we considering using ART bus on fixed route?

Leslie Keener: No, just for overcrowding use, for now.

Samuel Jensen: How was it decided where to put Micro Transit? Is there any public input?

Ben Garland: If purpose of micro transit is to provide access to fixed route, it might be a good opportunity to work with DMD to improve bike access as well.

Steve Pilon: Not very efficient lay out for bikes on ART bus.

Althea Atherton: We are not alone in having cleanliness issues on our buses, I've lived in other cities and use the public transportation.

Samuel Jensen: Perhaps drivers can do a quick sweep at the end of their shift to help with cleanliness.

Leslie Keener: We were looking at lower income areas in combination with Network study. It's a pilot program that is flexible. In October we handed out cleanliness bags to our drivers to help with that.

Althea shared screen on City of Albuquerque 2024 Transit Equity Day Resolution, changes and additions were made by TAB members.

Samuel called a vote for the amended Resolution. Resolution was voice approved by Althea Atherton, Ben Garland, Samuel Jensen, Patrick Martin, Jett Metcalf, Steve Pilon and Katherine Sullivan.
