ENACTMENT NO. <u>**R**-2019-052</u> COUNCIL BILL NO. \_ R-19-160 SPONSORED BY: Ken Sanchez and Isaac Benton, by request 1 RESOLUTION 2 ADOPTING A PROPOSITION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT THE 3 NEXT MUNICIPAL ELECTION CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF A QUARTER 4 OF ONE PERCENT TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE GROSS RECEIPTS TAX. 5 6 WHEREAS, since FY/2000, the City has renewed a voter approved 7 Transportation Infrastructure Gross Receipts Tax; and 8 WHEREAS, the voter approved Transportation Infrastructure Tax has 9 provided hundreds of millions of dollars in funding for road rehabilitation, 10 road maintenance, road deficiencies and transit operations; and **Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion** 11 WHEREAS, Albuquerque residents, visitors, and businesses have [Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 benefited greatly by the improvements funded from the proceeds of the 13 Transportation Infrastructure Tax; and 14 WHEREAS, the proceeds of the Transportation Infrastructure Tax have also 15 provided approximately 20% of the City's Transit operating funds; and 16 WHEREAS, the existing Transportation Infrastructure Tax contains a 17 sunset provision which causes the tax to expire on June 30, 2020; and 18 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of 19 Albuquerque to place a question on the ballot of the November 5, 2019 20 Municipal Election regarding whether to continue to provide this source of 21 road and transit funding. 22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 23 **ALBUQUERQUE:** 24 Section 1. That the City Clerk is instructed to place the following proposal 25 on the next municipal election ballot, and the gualified voters of the City of Albuquerque shall be permitted to vote "for" or "against" the following proposal: PROPOSITION SHALL THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE RENEW A ONE-QUARTER OF ONE 

PERCENT TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE GROSS RECEIPTS TAX WHICH SHALL BE DEDICATED SPECIFICALLY AND ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING USES: NOT LESS THAN 57% FOR ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS, TO INCLUDE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT **IMPROVEMENTS: 5% FOR TRAILS AND BIKEWAYS: AND 38% FOR TRANSIT?** THIS IS A RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX. THIS WILL NOT INCREASE THE TAX RATE.
