

BY IMPLEMENTING REASONABLE AND SOUND ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROJECTS, THE CITY HAS SAVED MORE THAN FOUR MILLION DOLLARS FROM AVOIDED ENERGY COSTS, PNM REBATES AND REDUCED OPERATING COSTS." "RATHER THAN SIMPLY TALKING ABOUT RECYCLING, WE HAVE MADE SIGNIFICANT STRIDES WITH A NEW PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP ON A STATE OF THE ART RECYCLING PROGRAM.'

Under Mayor Berry's administration the City has completed **100 energy efficiency projects** — implemented 16.8 million dollars — and received over 400 thousand dollars in PNM Rebates.

We estimate these projects have a total avoided energy cost savings of more than 2.8 million dollars. We estimate these projects have a total maintenance and operating savings of more than 1.9 million dollars. These projects will have continued annual savings with pay-back periods of less than five to ten years. Previous to 2010, the City had only completed 17 energy projects for a sum total of 2.4 million dollars that had a savings of less than **700 thousand dollars**.
