> Under Mayor Berry's administration the City has completed 100 energy efficiency projects - implemented 16.8 million dollars - and received over 400 thousand dollars in PNM Rebates.
> We estimate these projects have a total avoided energy cost savings of more than 2.8 million dollars. We estimate these projects have a total maintenance and operating savings of more than 1.9 million dollars. These projects will have continued annual savings with pay-back periods of less than five to ten years. Previous to 2010 , the City had only completed 17 energy projects for a sum total of 2.4 million dollars that had a savings of less than 700 thousand dollars.
